This pocket guide is a quick reminder for when you are being photographed. For full explanations and detailed advice, please refer to the main guide.

Your Choice

- You decide. Say NO anytime.
- Don't be rushed or pressured.

Ask First

- Who is the photographer?
- Why do they want your photo?
- Where will it be used?

Consent

- Get information in writing (your language).
- Keep a copy & contact details.
- Withdraw consent if misled.

Safety

- Never pose in unsafe places.
- Refuse risky exposure (identity/location).
- Stop anytime if uncomfortable.

Dignity

- No re-enacting trauma.
- Photos must honour you, not humiliate.
- Protect privacy. Face, name, details are your choice.

Culture

- Reject requests against customs.
- Protect sacred/private traditions.

Future

- Ask about long-term use.
- Think about community impact.
